

# Pupil Premium Grant (PPG)

## September 2017

Pupil Premium is awarded to schools for the number of children who have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the last six years. Pupil premium is also allocated to Children Looked After and Post-Looked After.

At Benington Primary School PPG funding is used in the following ways:

- Teachers and teaching assistants working in small groups including PP pupils
- Provision of additional teaching assistants across the school to provide intervention and support for individuals and small groups
- Subsidised or funded residential trips
- Working with parents to update them on supporting their children. Both LPPA and SFW.
- Training and courses for teachers and TA's
- Additional pastoral care for well - being including nurture groups and one to one mentoring
- Booster sessions after school with DHT
- Additional support materials and resources e.g. reading books to encourage regular reading

## 2016/17

For the academic year 2016/17, funding for Pupil Premium was £9240

The funding was used in the ways listed on the first page. The progress and attainment of pupils eligible for PPG are tracked and monitored individually. All eligible pupils receive tailored interventions which are monitored and tracked.

## 2016-17 Outcomes

Due to very small numbers of eligible pupils in each cohort, outcomes are reported in overall terms to prevent individuals being identified.

## EYFS

100% of disadvantaged children achieved GLD in 2017. 100% made expected progress through the prime areas of learning and in literacy and maths.

### KS1

There were no Pupil Premium children in KS1.

## KS2

100% of PPG pupils in year 6 met the expected standard in reading writing and maths in 2017. 50% made above expected progress in SPAG. 100% of pupils made progress similar to and at times above that of non-disadvantaged pupils in reading, writing and maths as a direct result of targeted support and effective use of the pupil premium grant.
