
Attendance

Safeguarding & Health and Safety

Please be aware that in Acorn and Willow Class staff only send out children when they can see their named adult. In Beech Class staff go out to supervise but we begin building up children's own responsibility by asking them to share when they see their parent and come back if they're not there. In Oak Class children are trusted to locate their trusted adult independently and return if they're not there. If you would prefer staff in KS2 to only let your child out when they see your child's trusted adult please let the class teacher know. This process is about getting children secondary ready. Apologies if this was not made clear.

Emails

Please be aware that if you email staff during the school day it's unlikely they'll respond. If you have an urgent request such as a change as to who is collecting your child, please email admin instead.

Absences

If your child is absent for any reason please let the office know by 9:30. Please ensure that you do this even if you've let your child's class teacher know. Our preferred method is Arbor. This saves the office phoning you. If your child is off sick for more than 3 consecutive days we will be asking for medical evidence.
