Our reading room is finished. The children have loved using it. We're planning a grand opening soon.

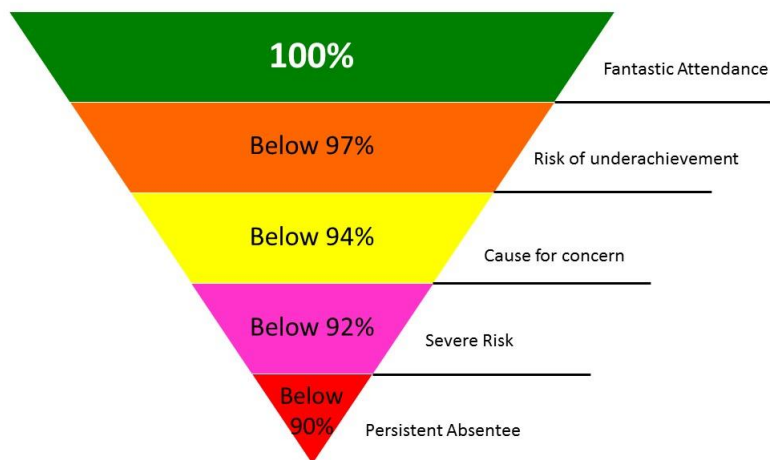
### **Attendance**

Please be aware that term time holidays and low attendance could incur a fine this year. Please make routine appointments for the dentist, optician etc outside of school time as this can also have a detrimental effect on your child's attendance. Please be aware that if we discover you have been on holiday, but have called in sick, we will be marking it as unauthorised. We'd much rather you were honest as the children are confused when we ask them if they're feeling better when they return!



## **Safeguarding & Health and Safety**

Please ensure any medication for your child is brought into the school office and the relevant forms completed. Please do not send your child with any medication in their bag without informing us.

## **Emails**

Please be aware that if you email staff during the school day it's unlikely they'll respond. If you have an urgent request such as a change as to who is collecting your child, please email admin instead.

## **Absences**

If your child is absent for any reason please let the office know by 9:30. Please ensure that you do this even if you've let your child's class teacher know. Our preferred method is Arbor. This saves the office phoning you. If your child is off sick for more than 3 consecutive days we will be asking for medical evidence.

## **Uniform**

We have lots of uniform available free of charge. You can just come to the front of school after drop off and go through to the Sycamore Room and help yourself.

## **Sports**

We have a dedicated sports board in the corridor. We use this to share success in sport such as earning swimming certificates, passing a ballet exam or earning a medal in football. Please send in a photo of your child with an explanation of their achievement and we can add it to the board.
