

# Pupil Premium Grant (PPG)

## September 2019

Pupil Premium is awarded to schools for the number of children who have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the last six years. Pupil premium is also allocated to Children Looked After and Post-Looked After.

At Benington Primary School PPG funding is used in the following ways:

- Teachers and teaching assistants working in small groups including PP pupils
- Provision of additional teaching assistants across the school to provide intervention and support for individuals and small groups
- Disadvantaged pupils are stretched and challenged and strategies are in place for teaching children a higher year group curriculum
- Subsidised or funded residential trips
- Working with parents to update them on supporting their children through LPPA.
- Training and courses for teachers and TA's
- Additional pastoral care for well - being including nurture groups and one to one mentoring
- Booster sessions after school with DHT
- Additional support materials and resources e.g. reading books to encourage regular reading

## 2018/19

For the year 2018/19 Benington Primary School 's funding allocation for pupil premium was £9,240.

The funding was used in the ways listed on the first page. The progress and attainment of pupils eligible for PPG are tracked and monitored individually. All eligible pupils receive tailored interventions which are monitored and tracked.

## 2018-19 Outcomes

Due to very small numbers of eligible pupils in each cohort, outcomes are reported in overall terms to prevent individuals being identified.

## EYFS

There were no disadvantaged children in EYFS

## KS1 SATS

Disadvantaged pupils made up 7% of the cohort and 7% did not meet standard across the board. We produce case studies for situations like this.

## KS2

There were no disadvantaged children taking SATS in KS2.
